Objectives

- Foster the development of the art of theatre
- Stimulate cooperation between member societies
- Educate the public as to the benefits of all aspects of Amateur theatre
- Provide training in the art or profession of acting, stage management and other areas of technical theatre
- Represent the views of the member to IOM Government and the Arts council.
- Promote live theatre through the Easter Festival of full length plays, One Act festival of plays and the Young Actor of Man Competition.

Membership

There are three types of membership available:

- **Affiliate Membership**
Open to all amateur dramatic and operatic groups. Each group can send two members to as their representatives and therefore has 2 votes
- **Life membership**
Life members are nominated by members of the executive committee, and are entitled to one vote each
- **Associate membership**
Individuals who are not members of a drama or operatic group, can join MADF provided they are nominated and seconded by members of the Executive committee. They do not have voting rights.
